Youth Certification Instructions

All Youth Certifications are valid for two years (except for Youth Exchange hosts) from the time your background clearance is received and passed, after which you will have to do a new Intellicorp background check and retake the quiz. PLEASE COMPLETE ALL 3 STEPS

STEP 1 – Complete Application

Download the District 5340 Youth Volunteer Application and complete it. Sign, scan and email to ypo@Rotary5340.org.

STEP 2 – Background Check

District 5340 has setup a special background check portal with IntelliCorp, a trusted third-party verification service that works with Rotary clubs and districts across North America. The service includes the following checks:

Social Security Number (SSN) Verification

Validated Multi-State Criminal Super Search Database

Validated Nationwide Sex Offender Registry

Validated Department of Corrections

Government Sanctions – Terrorist Search

Single Count Criminal Search

IntelliCorp does NOT pull credit reports and has strict controls in place that adhere to Fair Credit Reporting Act. To begin, simply visit youthcertify.candidatedirect.net and enter the password rotary5340. Cost of the service is \$13.60 plus any applicable county fees, which can be paid securely online. While most courts charge a nominal fee (In many cases, \$4-8), we have heard of significantly higher court charges. Unfortunately, these costs are imposed by individual court systems for performing the background check.

Follow the online instructions to authorize your background check and to make secure payment. Please select the "return results to me" option when entering your background information, as that will let you review your results. The district only receives an automatic pass or no pass notification regarding the background check.

STEP 3 – Online Testing

You must complete Part 1 and Part 2 (see below) of the online training program that was created specifically for Rotarians in District 5340. The training is free and can be reviewed at any time. Part 1 is a training video that can be accessed via YouTube.

Part 2 is an interactive test. Go to https://www.proprofs.com/quiz-school/story.php?title=mjq0mje2mqde3g to access the interactive test. You must retake the test until you receive a passing score of at least 16 correct answers. Your passing score is automatically reported to the District Youth Protection Officer.
