TO ALL ROTARIANS

As we enter the new Rotary Year, we are deeply appreciative of our ongoing relationship with Liberty Station Conference Center, Sodexo, and so many of our long-standing partners. As the world continues to evolve and grow, Rotary as an organization continues to follow that path.

We are writing to share that after an in-depth conversation with the Finance Committee, the Executive Committee and the Board, we have approved an increase in rotary dues and meeting costs that will take place on invoices moving forward. Liberty Station Meeting Cost will increase to \$37 per meeting. The beverage only option will continue to be charged at \$7 per meeting. Our rate is negotiated with the venue through June of 2025. If you are an active member, the annual dues cost going forward will be \$525. The amount billed quarterly for dues will be \$131.25. If you are a senior status member or young professional, the annual dues cost going forward will be \$325. The amount billed quarterly for dues will be \$81.25.

We are grateful for your continued membership to San Diego Rotary. Should you have any questions or if there is something we can do to address concerns you may have, please contact Jordan at the Rotary Office.
