Our new Youth Homelessness Committee, chaired by <u>Drew Moser</u> and <u>Zeynep Il-</u> <u>gaz</u>, has expanded both its purpose and reach by aiding and supporting homeless youth at San Diego Youth Services, Urban Street Angels and the Youth Assistance Coalition. We will merge resources, ideas and cooperation in a effort to support theses service organizations. We intend to provide bus and uber passes, hygiene and move-in kits and furnishings, "be a friend" personnel for one-youth-one Rotarian while doing grunt work projects and providing funding.

You can help this committee by doing any of the following:

- Referring catering and printing to Timmy's Place @ Urban Angels (go there on 1404 Fifth Av to amazing pizza+ sandwiches+salads+pastries AND printing services all kinds &am-2pm) operated by homeless youth in training at very reasonable prices
- Registering (2 hour training required) to "<u>Be a Friend</u>" at Urban Street Angels. (email Jerry at jerry@urbanstreetangels.org, for the info and application—When you meet the youth you will be excited!)
- Provide dinner service at Youth Assistance Coalition for 40-60 youth on weeknights (1848 Commercial St)
- Hire a youth as an intern or an employee.
