- Club expectations regarding member engagement including, attendance, participation in club committees, fundraisers and participation in club service activities, costs associated with being a member and paying dues on time
- Privileges of being a member of Rotary including attending meetings at other clubs worldwide; networking with community leaders; providing service to the community and world; and exposure to community organizations, etc. through weekly programs.
- After meeting with the prospective member and ascertaining the person's interest in joining Rotary, a sponsor questionnaire should be filled out by the Sponsor and submitted to the Rotary Office.
- Ed and Duke, Co-chairs of the Membership Committee will send both formal an informal communications and are available to help answer questions and help host at a meeting.
