BECOME A PLATELET DONOR

Kim Pretto has asked for assistance in getting members to donate platelets. Our beloved Chuck Pretto has been fighting cancer and is using them—sadly, there is a shortage.

Interested platelet donors should contact the [Blood Bank of San Diego](#) or the [American Red Cross](#) to schedule a donation.

The process of donation typically takes 2-3 hours. It involves drawing blood, separating platelets and returning the remaining components to the donor through an automated collection device. The actual platelet donation itself usually lasts around 90 to 120 minutes. Keep in mind that specific procedures might vary depending on the donation center or organization.
