#### **Youth Homeless Committee**













Homelessness is arguably San Diego's most pressing social issue.

More than 1,500 youth are among the homeless in San Diego County. Moreover, youth make up 12 percent of the county's unsheltered homeless population, higher than veterans at 10 percent and families at 3 percent.

Until recently our club supported "Storefront", the only emergency youth shelter in our city. Now, with the outreach and connections of Chairman Drew Moser and Vice Chair Zeynep Ilgaz, we are serving several homeless youth organizations including:

San Diego Youth Services
Youth Assistance Coalition
Urban Street Angels









Our youth homeless committee had a jolly time at Storefront this weekend, engaging in festive activities with the residents. Together, we decorated festive Christmas cookies and built gingerbread houses. It warmed our hearts to gift each child and staff member cozy presents, including snuggly blankets, comfy pajamas, and soft slippers. Storefront is the county's only emergency night shelter offering shelter and support services to homeless and runaway youth aged 12 to 17.


