Through our annual Project Allocation Committee (PAC) process, I am pleased to inform you that the grant application window for the next fiscal year (July 1, 2024 – June 30, 2025) is now open. The final date that applications will be accepted is Thursday, March 21, 2024. However, as the committee needs to go through each application and score them, it would be most appreciated if you could submit your application as soon as possible so that the committee has adequate time to carry out their task.

You will notice that this year's application has been revamped to include more substantive questions relevant to how PAC does its work to ensure that our members' donations to the Club are well-spent. I understand that this new application may take some additional time, but it is crucial that we understand the answers to all of these questions in order to be good stewards of the Club's funds. I appreciate in advance your diligent attention, and thoughtful answers to allow us to better understand the project underlying the grant, and the grant request itself.
