GET YOUR YOUTH PROTECTION CERTIFICATION NOW

Youth Protection Certification is needed for any Rotarian working with youth (under 18 years old) in any capacity. Start the process on THURSDAY, MAY 16 with an onsite LiveScan. The cost is \$50 if you pay cash and \$53 if you use a card. We'll also register you for the online training to complete on your own schedule. Bring your fee and a government issued ID (Driver's license, ID card or passport) and plan to come a little early. Once completed the requirements, your certification is good for 5 years for any Rotary activity.
